

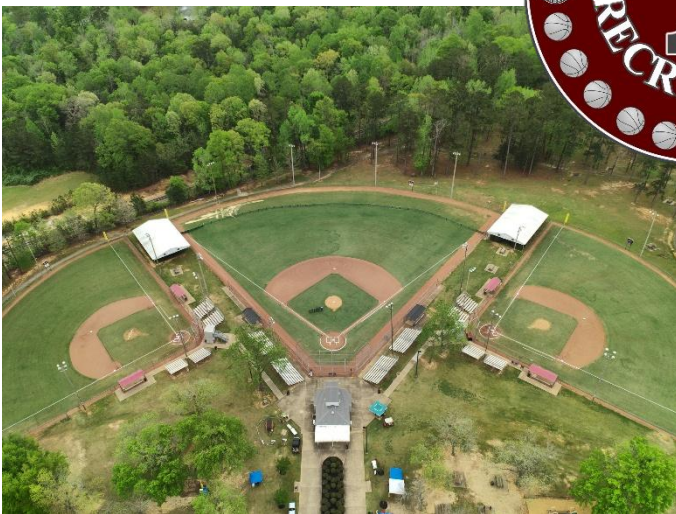

Please note the team manager must place ALL of the following documents to the Tournament Director. They must be prepared and assembled into a 3 ring binder. These documents must stay in possession of the Tournament Director until the team's last game.

- _____ Copy of the league accident insurance policy
- _____ Copy of the league liability insurance policy
- _____ Tournament team roster certified and signed by the League President
- _____ Signed consent for Treatment form for each player
- _____ Coaching Certification I.D. Card for manager and coaches
- _____ Letter of Eligibility

Park Policies:

- Personal coolers are not allowed in the complex and only **ONE TEAM COOLER** will be allowed. If a cooler is brought into the park and it is deemed a team cooler, it must remain in the dugout. Concessions will be available for purchase as well.
- Please remove all trash, gear, etc. from the dugouts and batting cages when exiting
- No sitting or tent set up will be allowed behind home plate
- Absolutely no air horns or artificial noise makers
- No personal transportation will be allowed inside the gates
- No use of tobacco, vaping products, and/or alcoholic beverages on property during events, games, or practices

- No bicycles, skateboards, scooters, heelys, rollerblades, or hover boards are allowed inside the park
- **Any spectator or coach who becomes disruptive will be asked to LEAVE the park immediately and indefinitely**
- Pets are NOT ALLOWED in the park, no exceptions.

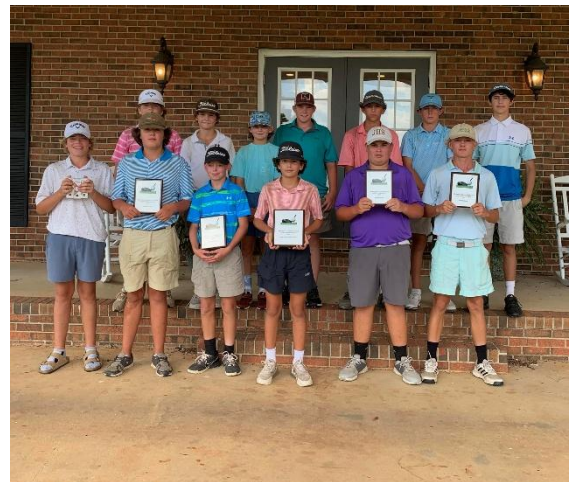
